

# **Crawford County Pageant Rules**

## **(Tiny Princess, Princess, Little Miss, Jr. Miss, & Teen)**

1. Contestant ages - please see chart listed on page 83 under pageant meeting.
2. A contestant must compete in the pageant sanctioned by the County Fair that is held in the county where she resides or attends school. Contestants must either legally reside or attend school (academic, not dance, etc.) in that county for one full semester prior to county's pageant. In the event a contestant whose parents are divorced and live in separate counties, and has been court ordered to reside jointly with both parents, she can only compete in one of the two counties in which her parents reside.
3. Contestants must attend registration meeting and scheduled practice.
4. A winner of a title may not compete again in the same division in which she holds a title, you must wait until you move up into the next age group.
5. Contestant must participate in the Fair Parade held in downtown Mulberry. Contestant must ride in an open vehicle. It is the responsibility of the contestant to provide her own vehicle & signage. Contestant must be in line no later than 10:00am on Church Street. **Tiny Princesses, Princesses, Queens & Seniors stay to left side of street; Miss Teen, Little and Jr. Miss contestants to right of street.**
6. Judges decisions are final. Score sheets will not be handed out after pageant. All score sheets are destroyed after the event.
7. If for any reason the "Winner" is unable to fulfill her obligations, or for any behavior which the pageant director deems unacceptable of a "Winner", they will relinquish their title IMMEDIATELY, and all privileges connected with the said title, together will ALL prizes awarded to her, and a runner-up shall be awarded all prizes as if she were chosen "Winner" on pageant night - her crown, sash, and every gift not inscribed with her name. She shall be succeeded by the next eligible contestant.
8. If for any reason, your permanent residence should change within your reign to outside Crawford County, or the school you attend changes, privileges connected with the said title shall also be handed down to the first runner up.
9. Miss Teen Contestants - A contestant cannot be, or at anytime have been married or have had a child. If winner becomes pregnant or decides to get married during her reign, she will relinquish her crown. First runner up will become the new Miss Teen. Contestant that is crowned Miss Teen will represent Crawford County at the AR State Fair in October in the Teen competition.
10. Any display of poor sportsmanship and/or unbecoming conduct, and interference and/or disturbance, or any behavioral problem created by a contestant, chaperone, parent, relative or even a supporter of a contestant could result in disqualification of the contestant not only from this year's contest, but also from future contests.
11. All contestants must attend the registration meeting at the commercial building at the fair grounds. Photos will also be taken for the newspaper.
12. All contestants need to furnish a 4x6 photo for the photogenic division of the pageant.
13. Sportswear division for teen: represent your favorite sport (dance, fishing, boxing, cheerleading, hunting, etc)

**Entry fee, entry form & photo will be required for entry day of meeting.**
